

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS AND REVISIONS TO THE BYLAWS OF THE OUTRIGGER CANOE CLUB

The following proposed amendments to the bylaws are those referred to in the call of the Annual Meeting of the members of the Outrigger Canoe Club, to be held on the Club premises at five p.m. on Monday, February 28, 1977, and are recommended by the Board of Directors.

The brief explanatory notes in italics following each Section are intended to assist the members in understanding the intent of the proposed revisions.

<p>Section 7 (f). Powers of the Board of Directors.</p> <p>To incur such special indebtedness as they deem necessary not exceeding Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) in any one year.</p> <p><i>Note: With the extraordinary increase in the cost of goods and services (i.e. sealant for garage, new roof on clubhouse) over the last couple of years, it is essential to increase the Board's discretionary powers so that the directors can contract for anticipated maintenance and repairs upon the clubhouse and grounds.</i></p>	<p>Section 7 (f). Powers of the Board of Directors.</p> <p>To incur such special indebtedness as they deem necessary not exceeding Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) in any one year.</p>
<p>Section 27. Classes of Membership.</p> <p>Lady. Widows of Senior, Regular, Intermediate members.</p> <p><i>Note: Present classification discriminates against all other classes of members in favor of women, contrary to the present notion of equality between the sexes. Lady members will be reclassified in other appropriate categories with the applicable dues of that class.</i></p>	<p>Section 27. Classes of Membership.</p> <p>Delete.</p>
<p>Section 42. Reinstatement.</p> <p>....Any member who has relinquished his membership upon marriage to another member may be reinstated without compliance to the above or Section 26.</p> <p><i>Note: Errata</i></p>	<p>Section 42. Reinstatement.</p> <p>Any person who has resigned his membership may be reinstated upon recommendation of the Admissions and Membership Committee and approval of the Board of Directors. Prior to reinstatement he shall pay the difference between the initiation fee on the date of resignation and the current initiation fee, or the dues accrued during lapse of membership. Any member who has relinquished his membership upon marriage to another member may be reinstated without compliance to the above or Sections 27 and 28.</p>
