Surf Ski Makes Bow Gift to Jack and John

"Wanna' go skiing at Waikiki beach? Of course I'm not kidding!" And, if the invitation comes from either Jack MacKenzie or Johnny Hollinger, veteran Outrigger Canoe club members, it's not a practical joke either.

Recently, Jack and Johnny received an Australian surf ski from Monty Walker, of Walker & Walker, stock-brokers, Sydney, Australia.

The gift was reciprocation for hospitality shown Mr. Walker by Jack and Johnny when Mr. Walker was in Honolulu last July with the Australian surf and swimming teams.

The surf ski is made of Australian mahogany, weighs about 120 pounds and measures, nautically speaking, about 18 feet from stem to stern.

The ski carries one passenger, and is manipulated by a single paddle with a blade at either end. The ski is hollow inside and slightly arched.

Mr. Walker, who was one of the sponsors of the Australian surf and swimming teams, had Jack's and Johnny's names placed on the gift.

Jack and Johnny estimate the ski is worth about \$75.

They say it can be used to do everything that can be done on a surf-board.
