

## New Outrigger Club Plans Moving Along Smoothly

Work on the new Outrigger club is getting along rapidly, says J. C. Shipp, club manager. He outlines the status of the work and the financing as follows:

"The multitude of details connected with the planning for the erection of the new home of the Outrigger Canoe club has been brought to a satisfactory conclusion.

"This will be welcome news not alone to the members but to hundreds of others who are interested in seeing this 30 year old institution permanently established in a modern building worthy of its past record and with ample provision made for its future growth.

"The decks are cleared for action, work on the new buildings will be started as soon as the bond subscriptions are forthcoming in response to the call already made, and when Architect Dickey completes the working drawings on which he is now busily engaged.

"Based on the preliminary cost estimates the club has sufficient resources from bond subscriptions and memberships to pay for the buildings in full without further indebtedness beyond the bond issue.

If the final contract exceeds the estimate, the club may need a few thousand dollars more, but that should present no difficulty. With the present membership of 700 or more every obstacle will be overcome.

"This membership assures ample revenue to meet operating expenses, bond interest and sinking fund requirements.

"Cooperating with the lessee of the Kalakaua frontage, the directors have arranged for an extremely attractive approach and club entrance from Kalakaua Ave., leading immediately to the main office and locker room building, then through the play area to the clubhouse on the beach front.

"The clubhouse will no doubt prove a popular gathering place, where members and their guests may enjoy excellent meal and bar service in the large glassed in lounge or on the adjoining sun deck.

"The Outrigger Canoe club already has a world wide reputation and it should become one of the famous clubs of the world, and certainly the largest and most attractive club in Honolulu."
