

Stores To Flank Entrance to New Outrigger Club

An arcade of stores will be built around the entrance to the new Outrigger club by Fred R. Kingman, prominent national sales and advertising businessmen.

This announcement was made Saturday by Mr. Kingman simultaneously with an announcement by Rep. Walter Macfarlane, OCC president, that the financing of the new clubhouse was complete.

The arcade and the new clubhouse together will cost more than \$100,000. Drewry H. Baker is the architect for Mr. Kingman's stores. Mr. Baker has cooperated with C. W. Dickey, architect for the clubhouse, to achieve architectural harmony in the stores and the clubhouse.

Mr. Macfarlane said that OCC membership has been increased from 250 to more than 750. Construction of the new clubhouse should start in two months, he said.

Lease transactions for Hawaiian Hotels, Ltd., owners of the property, were handled by Chauncey Cleveland, Honolulu real estate broker. Mr. Cleveland also will handle rentals of Mr. Kingman's stores.
