

New Outrigger Club Building To Be Started

Construction of the new \$65,000 Outrigger Canoe club at Waikiki is expected to start either on June 20 or 30. Walter J. Macfarlane, club president, announced today.

Within two or three days Mr. Macfarlane will close the construction contract with Ralph E. Woolley, contractor. It is expected the new club will be ready for formal dedication on January 1 of next year. Mr. Macfarlane said.

On July 1 initiation fees for prospective members will be increased from \$10 to \$25, he added. There are now more than 700 members in the OCC.

Announcement of the approaching date of construction signals the success of the club's fund raising and membership drive.

Two buildings will be erected at the club site on Waikiki beach. The clubhouse, fronting the beach, will have on its ground floor a lanai cafe, terrace overlooking the beach, informal grill and fountain for bathers. A large lounge and an open deck for sun bathing will take up the second floor area.

Mauka of the clubhouse will be the new clubhouse. In the center of the property, between the clubhouse and bathhouse, will be the play area, equipped for volleyball, handball, paddle tennis and badminton.

Typical Hawaiian furnishings and decorations will be used throughout.
