

Rep. Macfarlane Seeks Fourth Term In House

Rep. Walter K. Macfarlane, one of Hawaii's best known young businessmen, last night formally announced his candidacy for a fourth term in the House of Representatives, seeking reelection as a Republican from the fourth district, Oahu.

First elected to the House six years ago, Rep. Macfarlane was reelected in 1936 and again in 1938, being among the leaders in total number of votes cast each time. Rep. Macfarlane has been a member of the House finance committee for the past three sessions. He is a nephew of Princess Abigail Kawananakoa and of the late Senator Robert W. Shingle.

Educated at Punahou and the University of Hawaii, Rep. Macfarlane entered the business field here soon after his graduation. He is a partner in the advertising firm of Bowman, Holst, Macfar-
