

Outrigger Canoe Club Formally Open June 11

Canoe Racing, Dinner Are Planned for Event

Formal opening of the Outrigger Canoe Club's beautiful new clubhouse at Waikiki beach has been set for Kamehameha Day, June 11, when a program of canoe racing and other sports and a gala dinner dance will be staged, it was reported yesterday by Walter Macfarlane.

Mr. Macfarlane said that furniture for the clubhouse has arrived and is being installed. The entertainment committee is completing plans for the occasion and all members will be advised of the

program at an early date, he added.

More than 1,000 members and their friends were given a preview of the beautiful \$80,000 clubhouse and grounds on Feb. 16, when an informal opening was held. Although the club premises have been in use since January, completion of several units was held up because of delay in shipping furniture and other materials.

The new buildings of the famous organization started more than 30 years ago, were designed by Architect C. W. Dickey and constructed by Contractor Ralph E. Woolley. The locker rooms are located in a building occupying
