

Beach Patrol Opens June 1

Sally Hale, former captain of the Waikiki Beach Patrol, will re-open the Beach Patrol on June 1, he announced yesterday.

Through the cooperation of the Outrigger Canoe Club, all facilities of the old patrol will be used under the new setup, and canoe surfing, surfboard riding, swimming instruction and umbrellas will again be some of the attractions of Waikiki Beach.

The Beach Patrol office will be located in the Diamond Head end of the club pavilion on the beach, and Sally Hale will be on hand to give the service for which the old Waikiki Beach Patrol became famous. The patrol will arrange canoe surfing parties, either by moonlight or in the daytime, and surfboard instruction.

The Waikiki Beach Patrol will act as a clearing house for all the beach boys, Mr. Hale said.
