

Beach Sports At Outrigger

Big Program Planned For New Club Opening Kamehameha Day

Sports will play a prominent part in the official opening of the new Outrigger Canoe Club on June 11th, Kamehameha Day. An attractive program of beach activities has been arranged by a committee consisting of Sally Hale, Tom Blake and Herb Fox.

Starting at 2 p.m. canoe and surfboard sailing races, surf-riding contests, canoe races for both men and women and a six-man tug-of-war will be held.

The events are open to all—not restricted to club members—with trophies donated by Walter Macfarlane, Walter Flanders and Jack Bowden, club manager, going to the winners. Medals will also be awarded in all events.

Duke Kahanamoku, George (Dad) Center and Tom Blake will act as judges.

The Program

The complete program follows:

2 p.m.—Canoe sailing for trophy, sur-board sailing for trophy.

2:30 p.m. — Open surf-riding contest for gold, silver, bronze medals. 14 feet board limit. Start from shore — round buoy outside break (placed according to surf conditions.) ride and paddle to life-guard tower, once, twice, three times and to shore to win.

3 p.m.—6 man canoe race (6 gold medals to winners). Start from shore (O. C. C.) out to buoy, outside break, ride wave, paddle around life guard tower, once, twice, three times to win.

3:30 p.m. — Girls. Surf-board riding, paddling contest, (Medals for first, second and third.) Start from shore, paddle to break, ride, paddle to shore to win.

4 p.m.—4 man canoe race—gold medals to member of winning crew. Start from shore, paddle around buoy outside break, ride wave, paddle to shore to win.

4:15 p.m. — 6 man canoe tug-of-war, Eliminations and Finals. 6 Gold Medals to winning team.
