## Formal Opening Wednesday Of New Outrigger Club

Formal opening of the Outrigger Canoe club will be held Wednesday with beach activities, surf races, dinner, dancing and entertainment for members of Honolulu's kamaaina beach organization in its spacious new home at the center of Waikiki.

Activities get under way at 1 p. m. with surf races starting at 2. Races include an open surf riding contest, six men canoe race, girls' surfboard paddling contest, four men canoe race and six men canoe tug of war. (See sports page of details.)

Several trophies and gold medals will be awarded winners. Races are open to all, including nonmembers.

A cocktail hour and inspection of club facilities will be held from 5 p. m., with dinner and entertainment in the new lounge and dining room from 7 to 7:30 p. m.

Dancing is set for 8:45 to midnight in the new clubhouse to the music of Don Donley's band.

Walter J. Macfarlane, Outrigger club president, and Jack Bowden, manager, will award prizes and preside over the entertainment.

Modernization of the 32 year old Outrigger Canoe club was inaugurated two years ago. Since then over \$80,000 has been spent on buildings and improvements, including locker rooms for men, women and boys; dining room, lounge, cocktail bar, sundeck, gymnasium facilities and open air courts for volleyball and paddle tennis.

An informal opening was held February 16. The formal opening Wednesday marks completion of the building enterprise.
