

Ka Moi Wins Another Race In Sailing Series

Skipped by Sally Hale, the Ka Moi won the second race of the current outrigger canoe sailing series Sunday off Waikiki Beach.

Captain Hale and his Waikiki Beach Patrol crew sailed the six mile course in one hour, 14 minutes. This was the Ka Moi's second consecutive win. Hale and his crew won the first heat race a week ago.

The Ka Moi's victory, however, was a narrow one yesterday. Skipper John Ernestberg, piloting the U Telling Me, finished a bare 30 seconds back of the winner.

Yesterday's victory gave the Ka Moi 10 more points toward the Royal Hawaiian trophy.

Currently leading the series with a total of 20 points, the Ka Moi won the Eastman Kodak trophy by dint of her victory yesterday.

Tied for second in the canoe race series are John Ernestberg's U Telling Me, John Kaupiko's Nukunuku and Gordon Fischer's Hoonau. They have garnered 12 points apiece.

Charlie Amalu's Keeaumoku follows with three points.

Toot's Mineville Toots 11 and Doris Cromwell's Lahilahi failed to finish yesterday.

The final race of the series gets under way on Labor Day, September 1 with the Tommy Kearn's trophy at stake.
