Senator Alice Kamokila Campbell of Hawaii, here to discuss Hawaiian homestead matters with Delegate Joseph R. Farrington, had her conferences interrupted when she left today for Oakland, Cal., on word that her son, Walter J. Macfarlane, is very ill in a hospital there with typhoid fever.

It is expected she will return as Delegate Farrington planned to have her discuss with house and senate territories committee members her criticism of certain homestead matters.

A message received here today said Mr. Macfarlane's fever is now complicated by pneumonia.
