

List Events For Sunday

Twelve races, the feature event being a canoe race with the Walter Macfarlane perpetual trophy at stake, have been arranged for the surfboard and outrigger canoe racing program to be put on at Waikiki beach Sunday, July 4, under the auspices of the Outrigger Canoe club.

The program will be opened about 9:30 Sunday morning with a sailing race that will last about an hour and a half. This will permit the canoe and surfboard races to get under way around noon.

The list of events was announced today as follows:

1st Event—Mixed, tandem surfing championship. Partner must be 15 years of age or over. This event shall be run the same as the open surfing championship except that there shall be three series of waves instead of five.

2nd Event—Open surfing championship—open to all boards, all makes. Each entry shall be identified with a number fastened to his trunks. A starter shall be situated in a canoe on the breaker line with a large pole and flag. When a series of waves come up, the starter shall raise his flag and all entries shall endeavor to catch the first wave in the series. If first wave is missed, entry shall attempt to catch the second or third wave or until 20 men have passed the finishing canoe where judges will be located. Surf riders shall be judged on their stance, length of ride and ability to control board. Judge at finishing point will have a large checkered flag on a pole when 20 men have passed the judges, this flag will be raised and it will constitute the end of a series. All surfers will then return to the starting point and will await the starter's signal for another series of waves. There will be five series in the open championships.

3rd Event—Juniors six men canoe race—around markers two times coming back parallel with the shore to finishing line.

4th Event—Girls six men canoe race—one time around marker and back to finishing line.

5th Event—Boys six men crew race—one time around marker and back to finishing line.

6th Event—Service—enlisted men canoe race—one time around. Any of the enlisted men, either army, navy or marine is welcome to enter in this race.

7th Event—Service—officers canoe race.

8th Event—The Walter Macfarlane perpetual trophy—six men crew—three times around marker either paddling or surfing in on the third time around the marker and parallel with the beach for the last 200 yards to the finishing line directly opposite the Outrigger Canoe club.

9th Event—Women's four in crew—open—parallel with the beach.

10th Event—Tug of war.

11th Event—Two men canoe—parallel with the beach.

12th Event—Four men canoe—parallel with the beach.
