

# Gala Beach Show Sunday

A colorful and gala beach program sponsored by the Outrigger Canoe club—the Walter Macfarlane Memorial races—should attract thousands of spectators to Waikiki beach.

Activities begin at 11:30 a. m. with seven Mid-Pacific boats from the Kaneohe Yacht club competing in a race that will start and finish only a short distance from the shoreline.

Fifteen other events are listed, including surf paddling, outrigger canoe races an dtug of war not to mention music and other entertainment.

The Star-Bulletin is sponsoring the junior race, a six men canoe paddling event for boys.

The program is:

1. Mid-Pacific sailing boats, known as MP's, from the Kaneohe Yacht club, will race against each other.

2. Mixed tandem surfing championship.

3. Open surfing championship—open to boards of all makes. There will be five series of waves for contestants to ride in this event.

4. Six men canoe race. Distance will be around markers two times, coming back parallel with the shore to finishing line.

5. Girls six participants' canoe race. Distance one time around marker and back to finishing line.

6. Star-Bulletin trophy — Junior six members crew race. Distance one time around marker and back to finishing line.

7. Service (enlisted men) canoe race. Distance one time around marker and back to finishing line.

8. American Factors trophy—Service (officers) canoe race.

9. The Walter Macfarlane perpetual trophy donated by Matson Navigation Co.—six men crew, three times around marker either paddling or surfing.

10. Women's four in crew, open, parallel with the beach.

11. Tug of war—10 men.

12. Two men canoe race—parallel with the beach.

13. Four men canoe race—parrallel with the beach.

14. Six men canoe race—parallel with the beach.

15. Fathers' race—six men crew.

16. Canada Dry trophy—Relay race. Start at Halekai.
