Elect Nine At Annual Meet Of Outrigger Club

Nine directors were elected at the annual membership meeting of the Outrigger Canoe Club Wednesday when about 300 senior members attended.

Directors to serve for the year are Stafford L. Austin, vice president of C. Brewer Co., Ltd., Dr. Irving Blom, Maj. Samuel Fuller, valuation engineer of the territorial tax office, Wilford D. Godbold, acting city and county attorney; Leslie A. Hicks, pres-ident and manager of Hawaiian Electric Co., Ltd., Duke Kahanamoku, sheriff, city and county of Honolulu; Louis Le Baron, associate justice of territorial' supreme court; Harold A. Mountain, assistant secretary of Mat-son Navigation Co., and Thomas G. Singlehurst, vice president and treasurer of Bishop Trust Co. All directors elected are incumbents with the exception of Mr. Austin.

Two amendments to the bylaws of the club were voted on and adopted. The first was to increase the board of directors to 11 members, beginning in 1946. Of these 11, six will serve for two years and five to serve one year. The second amendment set up machinery to create an advisory committee whose duties would be to set up and admin-ister a building fund, which will be certain proportion of net receipts of the club. These men will have the power to invest, sell reinvest and administer this fund with the object of eventually building up a reserve for a permanent home for the club in the future.
