

FEATURE RACE AT WAIKIKI OVER 4½ MILES

Outrigger canoe club officials today announced a 12 event program for the annual Walter Macfarlane memorial canoe races which will be staged next Sunday, starting at 1:30 at Waikiki.

The races, sponsored by the Outrigger canoe club, will begin in front of the club pavilion and will go on throughout the afternoon with two special events being added to the program.

The blue ribbon event is the senior six men canoe race which will be over a four and a half mile course.

Competing will be such steersmen as Duke Kahanamoku, Johnny Hollinger, Turkey Love, Tommy Arnot, Tommy O'Brien, Dixon Reilly and Jeanne Richards, who will be competing for honors.

The army, navy, Uluniu, Hui Nalu and the Outrigger club will enter canoes in the various events.

The senior six men canoe race starts from the club, proceeds to a flag buoy near Populars surf, thence back to a buoy in front of the Moana hotel, and twice more around the buoy at Populars surf and back to the finish line between the judges' stand.

Here are the events as planned:

Service six men race (for enlisted men only).

Kids' six paddle race (kids under 16).

Junior six paddle race.

Service six men race (officers only).

Senior six men race.

Girls' six paddle race, open.

Senior two men race, open.

Girls' four paddle race, open.

Senior men's four paddle race.

Boys' six paddle race (boys under 12 only).

Relay race of two six men crews to each canoe.
