

Events Set For Big Canoe Races Sunday

An outstanding program of 12 canoe races will mark the second annual Walter MacFarlane Memorial celebration by the Outrigger Canoe Club this Sunday at the Waikiki beach.

This annual event is held in memory of the former president of the club, Walter MacFarlane.

The events will start at 1:30 p.m. with trophies to the winning crews.

The priceless Hawaiian racing canoes, brought out once a year, will be used in the races.

Blue ribbon event of the day is the senior six-man race over a course of three miles for the MacFarlane perpetual trophy.

The service women five-paddle race is one of the special events. Teams of Spars, Waves, Wacs, Red Cross and Marines will compete for honors in a featured number.

Six-crew (Girls open); **two-man** (senior); **four-crew** (girls open); **four-man** (senior); **six-paddle** (boys under 12); **relay—two six-man** crews to each canoe.
