

Canoe Races Slated Today

The aquatic classic of the year—the Walter Macfarlane memorial canoe races—will be staged this afternoon at Waikiki by the Outrigger Canoe Club. An outstanding program of 12 races will get under way starting at 1:30 p.m.

Three of the strongest canoe teams in the islands will compete for honors in the famed racing canoes which will be brought out for this special occasion. The teams are the Outrigger, Hui Nalu and Kaipoua.

The blue ribbon event of the day will be the six-man senior open race over a course of about three miles.

Service Special

A special feature race will bring together the women in service in a five-paddle event. Wacs, Spars, Waves, women Marines and Red Cross teams are entered.

The list of races in their order follows:

Service — six-man (enlisted men); six man (kids under 16); six-man (Junior); service—six-man (Officers); service—five-crew (Special); six-man (Blue ribbon).

Six-crew (Girls open); two-man (senior); four-crew (girls open); four-man (senior); six-paddle (boys under 12); relay—two six-man crews to each canoe.
