

Last Rites Today For A. H. Ford, Honolulu Publicist

With the Rev. Henry P. Judd of the Kaneohe Hawaiian church and the Rev. Dr. E. Tanner Brown of St. Clement's Episcopal church officiating, services for Alexander Hume Ford, 77, Honolulu publicist and organizer, who died here on Sunday, will be held at 4:30 this afternoon at the Outrigger Canoe club, Kalakaua avenue, in Waikiki.

A brief eluogy of the late Mr. Ford will be delivered on the occasion by Riley H. Allen, editor of the Star-Bulletin. The funeral arrangements are in charge of Borthwick's mortuary.

Directors of the Outrigger Canoe Club will act as pallbearers. The Honolulu Girls' Glee club will sing. The ashes will be sent to a sister-in-law, Mrs. F. W. Ford, in Georgetown, S. C., for interment.
