Gay Harris, acting manager of the organization, said six event will be staged for both men and women with attractive prizes offered the winners.

The races will be:

1. Castle swim, mile and quart

2. Public baths; for men over 40, three fourth mile.

3. Public baths, for women, three fourth mile. 4. Cunha swim, boys under 18, half mile.

5. Cunha swim, girls' novice, half

6. Boys and girls under 16 (canoe surf to beach).

The blue ribbon competition of the program is the Castle race for men. This is over a mile and a quarter distance and many of Hawaii's long distance swimmers are expected to enter.

Mr. Harris said that it is going to be surprsing when entries pour in for the men over 40 public baths race.
