

# Hargrave Wins Castle Swim

Six swim events, climaxed by a revival of the Thanksgiving Day Castle swim, were staged at the Outrigger Canoe club yesterday morning.

Only 24 entrants, 18 of them from the Punahou Athletic club, competed for the cups and medals awarded by the OCC.

Punahou swim coach, Robert Rath, and his squad provided the major portion of the competition.

Results, in order of events, were:

**Canoe race, boys under 16** (about 450 yards distance)—Won by Ian Kinnear (Pun AC). Second, James Murray (Pun AC); third, Robert Henderson (Pun AC), and fourth, Weldon McCullough (Pun AC). Time, 7 minutes 57.8 seconds.

**Canoe race, girls under 16** (about 450 yards distance)—Won by Betty Sumner (Pun AC). Second, Tita Marks (Pun AC), and third, Joane Barber (Pun AC). Time, 10 minutes 23.6 seconds.

**Cunha swim, boys under 18**—Won by Blaine Boyden (OCC). Second, Basil Hansen (OCC); third, Richard Larsen (OCC), and fourth, Nat Saltonsall (OCC). Time, 12 minutes 35.3 seconds.

**Cunha swim, girls' novice**—Won by Patricia Honl (Pun AC). Second, Yvonne Boyd (OCC), and third, Priscilla Freedman (OCC). Time, 15 minutes 23.8 seconds.

**Public bath swim for men over 40** (three quarter mile distance)—Won by Sam Kahanamoku (OCC). Second, Gay Harris (OCC). Only entrants. No time taken.

**Public bath swim, women open**—Won by May Freeth (OCC). Only entrant. No time taken.

**Castle swim (mile and a quarter)**—Won by Stan Hargrave (Pun AC). Second, Jock McIntyre (Pun AC); third, Lloyd Barraclough (OCC), and fourth, Phil Carricof (OCC). Time, 25 minutes, 45.5 seconds.
