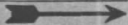


Red Cross Aid

A Red Cross canteen was set up early today at the home of Mrs. Stanley C. Kennedy, 5487 Kalaniano'le Highway, under the direction of Mrs. Kennedy to care for persons injured in the tidal wave, and to supply them with food.

First aid was administered to several persons who had suffered cuts from broken glass or from walking about trying to salvage their possessions out of the floods.

Coffee and sandwiches were prepared for the hungry persons in the affected areas.
