

# Duke, Weillers To Leave This Week for Coast

Duke Kahanamoku, famous Hawaiian aquatic figure and former Olympic champion, will travel with the Weiller brothers, Jerry and Bob, to the National AAU handball tournament in San Francisco on May 4.

Arrangements for Duke, who is sheriff of Honolulu, were completed Saturday for him to be the team manager, trainer and official Outrigger Canoe club representative, it was announced by Wilford D. Godbold, president of the beach club.

The brothers are scheduled to leave Honolulu on Thursday while Duke is ticketed to leave on Friday, however arrangements are in the offing for all three men to leave together. They travel by Pan American clipper and are expected to return to Honolulu in about 10 days after the matches.

Bob is currently the southern AAU doubles champion and a former national champion while his brother is the territorial singles champion, all-service singles champion, and a ranking national player.

They will play both in the singles and doubles divisions.
