## Crews Set For Kam Day Canoe Races

Eliminations for the Kamehameha Day canoe paddling regatta were held in the Ala Wai canal Sunday morning in two events, with two other scheduled heats cancelled because of last minute scratches.

In the Outrigger Canoe club's elimination for the senior 4-paddle event, Allen Love's team ousted Sam Kahanamoku's crew and will race in the finals against Hui Nalu, Kona and Natatorium.

Bill Hollinger's team was scratched in the half mile senior 2-paddle race, leaving Love's team the only Outrigger entry. Hui Nalu, Natatorium and Kona are also entered in this event.

The Junior Hawaiian Civic Club crew was eliminated in the one mile junior 6-paddle race, with Outrigger, Natatorium, Hui Nalu and Roosevelt qualifying.

Roosevelt scratched from the half mile junior 4-paddle, leaving Outrigger, Natatorium, Hui Nalu and Junior HCC.

The 11-race finals will be held on Kamehameha Day (Tuesday) starting at 9:30 a.m. All junior races will start at the ewa end of the canal and finish on the Diamond Head side. Senior races will start from the Diamond Head side and finish near the McCully bridge.

Parking space for cars will be available at the Ala Wai park, and each car will be admitted for \$1.

The regatta is under the sponsorship of the Kamehameha Day celebration commission, with the Kamaaina Beachcombers Hui handling the program.
