A colorful 10 event program featuring boats from the Outrigger Canoe club, Army and Hui Nalu will be offered holiday crowds, with the first race scheduled for 10 in the morning.

Valuable prizes and awards will be made to winners of all events, with victors of the blue ribbon event, the six man senior crew race over four miles, receiving the Walter P. Macfarlane perpetual trophy.

The order of events follow:

- 1—Junior six paddle canoe open.
- 2—Senior two paddle canoe open.
- 3—Women six paddle canoe open (male steersman).
- 4—Senior four paddle canoe open.
- 5—Junior two paddle canoe open.
- 6—Senior six paddle canoe open.
- 7—Boys under 14 six paddle canoe, steersman to be selected by coach and crews. Canoes to be drawn by steersman.
- Special—Tuy "o" war canoe, 6 or 8 paddle canoe. Winner by process of elimination.
- 8—Men over 40 six paddle canoe open, steersman and canoes to be selected same as event 7.
- 9—Relay. Two crews of six men each using one canoe.
