Outrigger Crew Rescues Sailor Adrift Off Waikiki

Sheriff Duke P. Kahanamoku and his crew of six outrigger crew enthusiasts rescued a young man identified only as "a sailor" Tuesday afternoon from a drifting surfboard off Waikiki.

The shivering surfer had developed cramps in his arms and was floating in the steamer lane about two miles off shore, according to the sheriff.

The outrigger group, practicing for the June 11 races, brought him in about sundown.
