Indian canoe, 2 paddle novelty (11/4 miles).

Men's junior, 6 paddle (1¼ miles). Women's junior, 6 paddle (1¼ miles). Kids under 16 years old, 6 paddle 1¼ miles).

Men's junior, 2 paddle (1¼ miles). Men's open hollow surfboard (1½ miles).

Men's junior, 4 paddle (114 miles).
