Surfboard rentals—\$1 an hour for solid redwood boards; \$2 for balsa and redwood boards. \$3 for hollow boards.

Swimming lessons — \$2.50 each; \$13.50 for course of six lessons.

Plans are being formulated to expand the activities of the organization to include other sports such as spear fishing, movies and still picture surfing, canoe sailing, etc.
