

# Scores 37 Points In Canoe Regatta

## Outrigger Edged Out In Final Event Of Day; Princeton Oarsmen Capture Special Event At Waikiki Beach

Driving from behind in the 11th and final event of the afternoon, Hui Nalu scored 37 points to capture the annual Walter Macfarlane Memorial canoe races at the Outrigger Canoe Club yesterday.

The Outrigger competitors, nosed out by Hui Nalu in the relay crucial, placed second with 34 points. The Honolulu Police were third with 14, followed by Outrigger Beach Service Club with 5 and Waikiki Surf Club with 1.

At the end of 10 events, Hui Nalu led by the one point. Outrigger seemed to have the final relay event sewed up when Hui Nalu caught two big waves and finished first by a length and a half to capture the championship.

In a special race among Midshipmen from the Navy vessels in port now, the Princeton crew defeated Dartmouth and Yale. The Old Nassau bunch suffered a ducking at the finish line but were far enough across to nose out the Green.
