

SEVEN CANOE RACES FRIDAY

The colorful Hawaiian Hookupu (athletic event) will be revived for the second time on Kamehameha Day, June 11 at 1 p. m. off Waikiki in front of the Outrigger Canoe club.

In an array of athletic events depicting Hawaiian aquatic rites, the Outrigger Canoe Club has scheduled a series of seven canoe races, a tentative surf board polo game, and tug-of-war.

The classic sports event re-enacts the ancient native tribute paid to Kamehameha I, conqueror and unifier of the Hawaiian islands. The picturesque occasion will be interspersed by hula conditions and by authentic ancient hula exhibitions by Iolani Luahini, the island's expert exponent of the old-time religious dance.

Expected to compete in the Outrigger Canoe Club sponsored events are the Honolulu Police, MaCabe, Hamilton & Renny, Hui Nalu, and Outrigger club teams.
