Cops Senior 6-Man Canoe Paddle Race

Crowd of 15,000 Sees Koolaupoko Lions Show at Kailua

One of the largest crowds ever to assemble at Kailua beach, an estimated throng of nearly 15,000 spectators, watched the Waikiki Surf Club defeat the Outrigger Canoe Club and Hui Nalu in the first annual canoe and surfboard paddling regatta of the Koolaupoko Lions Club yesterday.

Johnny Lind's Waikiki Surfers scored 54 points to OCC's 22 and Hui Nalu's 17.

The blue ribbon event of the day was the senior 6-man half mile canoe race which was won by a Waikiki Surf crew of G. Downey, Ed Whaley, R. Choi, P. Kaaihue, R. Takaki and W. Froeseith. Hui Nalu was second and OCC third, with less than five yards separating the three canoes. The time was 3 min. 50.5 sec.

Waikiki Surf also won the women's six half mile canoe event in 4 min. 15 sec., with Outrigger second and Hui Nalu third. Outrigger won the junior six-man race in 3 min. 50.9 sec. and Hui Nalu took the freshman six in 4 min. flat. Waikiki Surf captured the kids' six-man race in 4 min. 45.5 sec.

In the freshman race, the Waikiki Surf canoe was swamped at the quarter-mile mark.

George Downing of Waikiki Surf captured the senior men's surfboard half mile race in 5 min. 16 sec. Violet Makua, unattached, won the women's surfboard event, while Tommy Shroeder of Outrigger annexed both the junior and kids under 16 races. J. Pang won the redwood plank surfboard race over 100 yards and the 220 yards tandem event went to G. Downing and Esther Kalama in 1 min. 28.6 sec.

The special six-man canoe race for Lions Club crews was won by Koolaupoko by default.

Mrs. K. Russell Gregg presented the Kailua Businessmen Group's championship trophy to Lind, representing Waikiki Surf Club.
