Nine Events On Tap Off Waikiki

The Outrigger Canoe club's annual Walter James Macfarlane memorial canoe races will open at 10 Tuesday morning, July 4, off Waikiki beach.

Nine races are scheduled on the program, with the blue ribbon Senior-6 paddle for men listed No. 5.

The first event is the Junior-6 (men), one turn around outside flag. No. 2 in the Senior-2 (men) on a flat course, starting at Waikiki Tavern. The Wahine-6 (senior girls) race follows, one turn around inside flag.

No. 4 is the Kids-6 (under 17 men), one turn around outside flag. The blue ribbon test will call for three turns around the outside marker.

OTHER RACES LISTED

Freshmen-6 (men), one turn around outside flag is No. 6 on the program. Wahine-6 (junior girls), one turn around inside flag is next. No. 8 is the Junior-4 (men) race, one turn around inside flag, with Senior-4 (men), one turn around outside flag, closing the Independence Day canoe meet.

Entries from Hui Nalu, Outrigger Canoe club, Waikiki Surf club and Healani Rowing club will show in the colorful races. Medals to winning canoes will be presented from 3:30 to 5 p.m.

The annual events are held in memory of Walter James Macfarlane, who died in Oakland, Calif., in 1943. He was president of Outrigger Canoe club at the time.

A magnificent perpetual silver bowl trophy donated by Matson Navigation Co. and Hawaiian Hotels is at stake in the Senior Men's 6-paddle race. The order of events follows.
