

# Report Shows Good Year For Outrigger Club

Wilford D. Godbold was reelected president of the Outrigger Canoe club at a recent organizational meeting of the directors. Herbert M. Taylor, former treasurer, was elected vice president. Vincent H. Danford was elected treasurer and Samuel M. Fuller reelected secretary.

**AT THE ANNUAL** meeting the results of the balloting for six positions on the board of directors were announced.

From among 13 candidates the following were elected:

Duke P. Kahanamoku, Leslie A. Hicks, Mr. Taylor, Mr. Godbold, LeRoy C. Bush and the Rev. Henry P. Judd. All except the Rev. Mr. Judd were reelected.

Holdover directors are Robert D. Fischer, William Capp, Mr. Danford, William J. Mullahey and Mr. Fuller.

**THE OPERATIONS** of the club have been extremely successful the past year, Mr. Godbold pointed out in his president's report. The total membership is 1,858, and the club is completely out of debt. At the end of the last calendar year the net worth had increased to \$370,727, an increase of more than \$31,800 over the club's net worth for 1950. The last remaining note in connection with the additional improvements to the club, which was in the amount of \$10,000, has been paid in full.

The club building fund has a present value of approximately \$180,000.

**MR. GODBOLD** reported that the club membership has continued on the increase except in two categories. The associate membership has decreased during the past year from 182 to 143. The junior membership has also continued to decrease.

From a total junior membership of 237 in 1949, this membership dropped to 180 in December of 1950 and dropped again in the past year to 167.

**THE REASON** for the marked decrease in associate membership is that wives or husbands of regular members have been granted practically all of the privileges of the club without requirement of the payment of dues. These "spouse" members have full use of the dining room and bar.

The regular membership has continued to climb from 752 in 1949 to 827 in 1950 to 858 as of December 1951. There are now 867 members in this category.

**LAST MONTH** the board authorized monthly movies for the children and adults. The board is now working on plans for varied membership activities which would make the best use of available space.
