

# Kona Regatta Is Scheduled For Saturday

Excitement reigns among Oahu's five canoe clubs today, anticipating, still practicing and hoping for victory at the revived Kona Regatta to be held in Kailua, Hawaii, Saturday.

A total of 114 men and women qualified in three elimination regattas. Approximately 60 more will also fly to Kona to take part in the weekend races.

The 114 who qualified will enjoy the weekend with all expenses paid by the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association.

Big Island competition will be provided by the Kai Opua Club and the Honaunau Club.

John Lind, president of the HCRA, returned from a Kona trip last week and reported a crowd of 10,000 is expected to be on hand for the first Kona regatta since 1935.

Honolulu's men crews will be housed at the Kona pier and Kailua gym while the women will be quartered at Kalahau Hall.
