Waikiki Surf Captures Senior Six

Large Crowd Witnesses Titular Canoe Races

KONA, Hawaii, Aug. 9—The Outrigger Canoe Club won the Julian Yates Hawaiian Canoe Paddling championship regatta here today before an estimated crowd of 12,000, with 28 points. Kai Opua of Kona and the Waikiki Surf Club tied for second place as they scored ten points each. Hui Nalu was third with eight points. Outrigger captured five races in the nine-event program.

Excellent weather conditions and smooth water prevailed to make for well paddled races.

Although OCC won the regatta, Waikiki Surf Club annexed the blue ribbon event—the senior men six—in 25 minutes 46.8 seconds. Outrigger was second and Hui Nalu third. Kai Opua was fourth and Honaunau fifth.

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The women's six event went to Outrigger as they outpaddled the Honaunau crew. Waikiki Surf club was third. The OCC's winning time was 9:53.2.

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Outrigger also showed the way in the senior men four event in 8:34.7, edging out Hui Nalu. Kai Opua was third.

Outrigger captured the junior men six race over the Kai Opua and Honaunau crews, who finished second and third, respectively. OCC's time was 17:15.

The OCC's pennant flew high again when its paddlers crossed the finish line first in the junior men four event, trailed by the Waikiki Surf Club and the Hui Nalu in that order. The winning time was 9:03.5.

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Continuing their winning ways, Outrigger came through victorious in the junior women six in 10:23.1. Hui Nalu was second, and Honaunau third.

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Kai Opua of Kona won the freshmen six event over second place Honaunau and third place Waikiki Surf Club.

Kai Opua came back in the fifth race to triumph in an event for boys 17 and under, defeating Hui Nalu and Honaunau, who finished in that order.

In a special race for Kona crews—boys under 13—Honaunau defeated Kai Opua.
