Surfboard Title Race Scheduled Dec. 28

The fifth annual Diamond Head Surfboard paddling meet will be held Sunday, Dec. 28, at 11 a.m. in front of the Moana Hotel. Open to both men and women, the championship will be sponsored by the Waikiki Surf Club.

The blue ribbon event will be the championship six-mile race to the Diamond Head buoy and back. Two sets of prizes will be awarded, one to the entries using the racing boards and the other to those using the ordinary boards. Prizes will include trophies, medals, holomuus, and aloha shirts for the first three places.

George Downing who won the race the past three years will not defend his championship. He is in the Coast Guard and is stationed on the Mainland. **Rabbit Kekai** won the first race in 1948.

Other events scheduled are:

One mile for women; tandem race (men and women); redwood surfboard event; race for malihinis (men and women); run-swim-run event; coconut tree climbing event.

There will be Hawaiian music and entertainment during the races.
