

Surfboard Race Date Is Changed

The fifth annual Diamond Head Surfboard Paddling championship race has been postponed from December 28 to January 18 in order to allow the visiting members of the Australian life saving team to compete in the event.

This action followed a Tuesday noon meeting of the Waikiki Lions Club, which recommended the postponement. The Waikiki Surf Club, sponsor of the program, unanimously agreed to the change in date.

In addition to the six mile main event (in front of the Moana Hotel and back), the January 18 program includes the following:

Kids race, one half mile; wahine race, one half mile; Hawaiian red-wood plank, open, 100 yards; life-saving demonstrations by visiting Australians; malihini malabu surfboard race; run-paddle-run relay; coconut tree climbing event.
