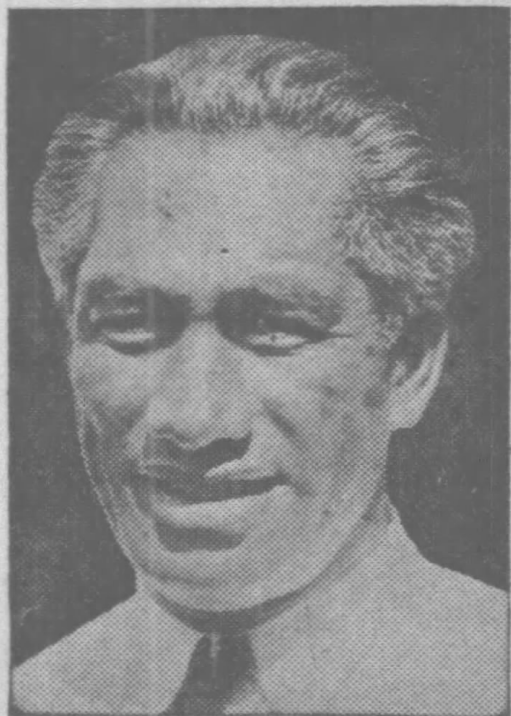


# *Kahanamoku Statue Planned For Beach*

Plans for the erection of a life-sized bronze statue to Duke P. Kahanamoku, Hawaii's world-famed swimmer, are now being formulated by members of the Kamaaina Beachcombers' Hui, an organization of local sportsmen who have worked together for the last 25 years to promote swimming in the Islands.

According to Theodore "Pump" Searle, president of the organization, the statue of Duke will be erected some place at Waikiki, near the Outrigger and Hui Nalu swimming clubs. Committees, headed by George "Dad" Center, of the Outrigger club, and John D. Kaupiko, of the Hui Nalu, will meet within the next week to discuss plans for a drive to raise funds.
