

# Canoe Racing Starts in May

The 1957 canoe racing season gets under way May 26 with the Maritime Day races in Honolulu Harbor.

Seven other regattas are scheduled for the year: June 9, Kamehameha Day; July 4—Walter Macfarlane Memorial in Honolulu and possibly another regatta at Kailua, Oahu; mid-July—Oahu championships; August 3—Territorial championships, Kailua, Kona; September 1-2—Koolaupoko Lions' Labor Day program; October—Molokai to Oahu race.
