

# Sally Hale Quits Outrigger Beach Job

Sally Hale, for many years a familiar figure on Waikiki Beach, confirmed today his resignation as head man of the Outrigger Canoe Club Beach Services after 18 years.

But he's not through with the beach yet.

Vacationing on Kauai, Hale said he quit at the end of March because he felt the Outrigger Club would not need beach services after it moves to the Elks Club site.

The club has more than six years remaining on its lease for the present site.

But Hale said he couldn't be sure when the move would be made.

He said he will return Wednesday to "look around" for another job—preferably on the beach.

"After all, the beach is my life," he said.

Hale is 54. His full name is Louis R. Sally Hale.

A spokesman for the club said Hale's successor has not been named yet. The matter is to be taken up by the club's directors, he said.
