Canoe Racing Slated For Sunday In Harbor

The first race of the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association's 1957 schedule will be held Sunday off Pier 9 at Honolulu Harbor.

Seven clubs will be competing with the first race to start at 10 a.m. The races will mark the end of a week-long observance of Maritime Day and are being sponsored by the Propeller Club under the HCRA's direction.

The 1957 Maritime Day event is being dedicated to Arthur M. Tode, honorary president of the Propeller Club of the United States.

A pre-race rally is scheduled for tonight at the Banyan Court of the Moana Hotel. It is slated to start at 7:30 p.m. and will include introduction of Dorothy Johnson, Miss Maritime Day, and brief talks by officials of the canoe association, Propeller Club, and hotel officials.

Waikiki Surf, Healani, Lanikai, Holomua, Outrigger, Hui Nalu and Kai Oni Canoe Clubs will provide the entertainment. The same clubs are competing in Sunday's 12-event program. General J. Perry, assisted by Alex Kahalepuna.

Paul Jones is again serving as chairman of the HCRA race committee. President of the association is Robert D. Fischer. Other officers include Boniface Aiu, vice president; Arthur Otremba, treasurer and director; Mary Jane Kahanamoku, secretary and director; and Jones.
