

Kahanamoku To Be Honored

Canoe Regatta Slated Sunday At Kailua Bay

Sheriff Duke P. Kahanamoku will be honored Sunday when the week-long Kamehameha Day celebrations wind up with the annual Kam Day canoe races at Kailua Beach in Windward Oahu.

Sponsored by the Kamehameha Day commission and directed by the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association, the 1957 regatta will feature seven clubs who will compete in 12 events.

The first race starts at 10 a.m. There will be three Windward Oahu clubs and four Honolulu clubs vying for honors. The Windward clubs and their coaches are Holomua, Sam Kaniau; Kai Oni, Stu Kalama; and Lanikai, George Perry.

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Coaches of the four Honolulu clubs are Healani, Buddy Young; Hui Nalu, John D. Kaupiko Sr.; Outrigger, George Downing; and Waikiki Surf, Noah Kalama.

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Blue ribbon event of the day is the men's senior six two-mile race. Outrigger Canoe Club holds the course record with a tie of 19 min. 42.3 sec. established last Labor Day at Kailua.

Paul Jones is chairman of the race committee which also includes Sam Hipa, Arthur Otremba, Leonard Rose and Francis Wight. Judges are Alex Kahalepuna, Dr. Donald Brown, Joseph Flores, A. E. (Toots) Minvielle and Hiram Olsen.

Inspectors are Arnold Capellas, Boniface Aiu, Al Barclay, Val Fagerroos, James Rodenhurst and Walter Rodenhurst. Sam Guerrero, J. Ahue, A. Ellis, and J. Morrison are the timers. The starters are Robert Fischer and James Alama.

This is the second HCRA race of the season. Waikiki Surf won the Maritime Day regatta last month and is again favored to make it two in a row Sunday.

Boys six, 17 and under, 1 mile—Healani 5, Holomua 6, Hui Nalu 4, Kai Oni 3, Lanikai 1, Outrigger 7, Waikiki Surf 2.

Boys freshman six, 1 mile—Healani 5, Hui Nalu 2, Kai Oni 3, Lanikai 6, Outrigger 1, Waikiki Surf 4.

Men's senior six, 2 miles—Healani 3, Kai Oni 4, Outrigger 1, Waikiki Surf 2.

Men's junior four, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile—Healani 4, Holomua 2, Kai Oni 1, Outrigger 5, Waikiki Surf 3.
