# Two Canoe Regattas Scheduled For Today

A 12-event regatta off Waikiki Beach and another nine events at Kailua Beach in Windward Oahu will be offered canoe racing enthusiasts in today's double-barrelled holiday attraction.

The Waikiki show is the annual Walter J. MacFarlane Memorial race sponsored by the Outrigger Canoe Club. Five clubs, Healani, Hui Nalu,

Kai Oni, Outrigger and Waikiki Surf, are entered.

Three clubs will be competing in the Kailua race sponsored by the Windward service clubs. Holomua, Kai Oni and Lanikai are the competing clubs. The first race at both courses will start at 10 a.m. The racing committee at Kailua is under the chairmanship of Arthur Otremba while Paul Jones heads the committee at Waikiki.
