## Eleven Clubs To Vie In TH Canoe Regatta

Eleven canoe clubs, including seven from Oahu, will compete in the 1957 Territorial championship regatta scheduled to be held a week from today at Kailua, Kona.

Three Big Island clubs and one from Kauai complete the entry list. Lanés will be assigned today when coaches are slated to meet with Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association officials at 1 p.m. at the

Ala Wai boathouse.

Waikiki Surf Club, which took the 1956 title, heads the Oahu entries. Others include Holomua, Healani, Kai Oni, Outrigger, Lanikai and Hui Nalu.

The Hilo - Kamehameha combine, Honaunau and Kai Opua of Kona will carry the Big Island colors. The Kauai

Canoe Club will represent the Garden Island.

Inter-Island Travel Service will sponsor this year's championship. The races will be conducted by the HCRA. Paul Jones heads the race committee. The 1957 territorial regatta will honor Frank Henriques, veteran canoe racing figure from Kona.

There are 12 events sched-

uled for next Saturday with the men's senior six two-mile race as the blue ribbon attraction. The first race starts at 10 a.m.

Among race officials slated to be at the regatta are Robert Fischer, HCRA president; Arthur Otremba, treasurer and race committeeman; and Mary Jane Kahanamoku, secretary and recorder.
