

# Waikiki Surf Club Cops Inter-Island Canoe Title

KAILUA, Kona, Aug. 5—Three Kona records were broken in the Territorial Canoe Racing championships Saturday in Kailua Bay.

Waikiki Surf Club won with 35 points, closely followed by Outrigger Canoe Club's 31.

Healani had 25, Kai Oni 20, Kauai 6, Kamehameha (Hilo) 5, Lanikai 4, Holomua 3, Hui Nalu 2, and Kai Opua (Kona) 1.

Strong currents delayed the program, and made the

races a real test, said officials.

The Outrigger crew of George Downing, Tom Moore, A. Smith, A. Kaaua, Doug Carr and L. Lemes won the senior men's six main event over Waikiki in the new record time for the course of 16:38.4.

They estimated that the fans and paddlers spent \$25,000 or more in Kona over the week end.
