

Kai Oni Leads Regatta

Kai Oni held a 4-point lead over second-place Healani at the conclusion of yesterday's opening program of the annual Labor Day Canoe Regatta at Kailua Beach.

The second half of the program got under way at 10:30 a.m. today with the wind-up race scheduled being the 2-mile men's senior six.

Kai Oni collected 19 points yesterday, winning the men's senior four, men's junior four and the boys 13 and under race.

Waikiki Surf Club and Holomua were in a third-place

tie yesterday with 14 points each.
