

37-Mile Race Draws 11 Canoes

Interest in the revived Molokai-Oahu canoe race appears to be picking up with 11 clubs prepared to make the rugged channel crossing.

The 37-mile race has been scheduled for October 20 at the start of Aloha Week.

The Waikiki Surf Club has dominated the event in recent years.

Clubs intending to compete are the Outrigger, Kai Oni, Kamehameha (Hilo), Hale Au Au, Hui O Lanikai, Kai Opua, Holo Mua, Hui Nalu, Healani, O Molokai and W.S.C.

Other entries will be received up to October 3. Only three clubs entered the revival in 1952.
