Open Water Swim Meet

An open water swimming meet may be held on New Year's Day in front of Kaiser's Hawaiian Village Hotel in Waikiki.

It was learned yesterday that plans for such a meet were being formed and that the Hawaiian Village Hotel will sponsor the event. Mary Jean Sears, aquatic director for the hotel, is expected to be in charge.

Miss Sears said she hopes to meet with coaches of swimming clubs at 11:30 a.m. today at the Hawaiian Village Hotel to setup plans for the event.

An open water meet has been held annually off Waikiki beach by the Outrigger Canoe Club. Fred Strere, a mem-

ber of the club's committee, said yesterday that the Outrigger has decided not to hold a meet this year.

The last Outrigger-sponsored meet was held last December, with George Onekea Jr. and Ivanelle Hoe, both of Hawaii Swim Club, winning the men's senior 2,000-yard and women's senior 1,500-yard events, respectively.
