

Outrigger Offer Will Be Canceled

International Building, Ltd., will withdraw on Feb. 1 a proposal under which Outrigger Canoe Club could remain on its present site, International General Manager William M. Cox said yesterday.

The offer was made Dec. 3, he said, and the canoe club has not replied.

Club President R. Q. Smith previously had said the proposal would not let the club continue privacy in operations, and that the offer was "no improvement" over an earlier one turned down by the club membership.

International is taking over the club's leased site between the Royal Hawaiian and the Moana Hotel. The club plans to build on the present Elk's Club site.
