

Bishop Estate Would Save 2 Beach Clubs

If the Sheraton Corp. builds facilities for the Outrigger and Uluniu clubs on the Royal Hawaiian Hotel grounds the Bishop Estate will buy them back from Sheraton when the chain's lease expires in 1975, according to Atherton Richards, estate trustee.

Richards said he feels it is to the chain's interest to keep the two institutions at Waikiki as places where tourists can meet islanders.

They are the only places left for residents on Waikiki beach, the trustee observed.

Queen's Hospital has consented to the transfer of the Outrigger site lease from Matson Navigation to Sheraton Corp. for no consideration.
